## DIRECTIONS FOR PORTFOLIO AND INTERVIEW SCORING

#### STAGE 1- ENTRY TO THE TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

#### **ENTRY PORTFOLIO**

Prior to the interview, check the entry portfolio to see the following are included:

- 1. Title page with name, major, content area, and contact information
- 2. Content Assignment
- 3. Philosophy of Education completed in EDUC 2123 The Teaching Profession
- 4. A copy of a lesson plan completed in EDUC 3403 or 3413 that is a sample of the candidate's best work.
- 5. Two evidences of effective Field Experience which should include:
  - Evidence 1: Selected log entries or course assignment demonstrating valid field experience
  - Evidence 2: Written reflection of all field experiences (what student has learned).
- 6. On-Demand Writing

#### Score the Portfolio using the Entry Portfolio Rubric and place in the Candidate's Interview File.

Evidence for 2, 3, 4, & 5 should indicate meeting each standard at an acceptable level or above. Any evidence at (1) unacceptable will require the candidate to resubmit the Stage 1 Portfolio.

#### **ENTRANCE INTERVIEW**

Before interviewing the candidate, share the candidate information with the interview committee on the "Program Entrance: Candidate Information Sheet" for GPA, course grades, Praxis scores, and Disposition Scores.

There is an Interview Form for both interviewers to complete during the interview.

Directions for Interview:

- 1. Questions must be asked from each of the five Kentucky Teacher Performance Standards included, BUT not all questions must be asked. Use the questions as a guide.
- 2. Add any additional questions in the space provided
- 3. Rate the candidate on the quality of the answers
- 4. Score the Oral Interview Skills of the candidate on page 3 of the form.
- 5. Please complete all interview feedback that is applicable.

#### STAGE 1 SUMMARY SCORE SHEET

To be admitted to the Education Program the candidate must score acceptable or above on the following:

- 1. Portfolio
- 2. Interview
- 3. Communication: Written and Oral
- 4. Dispositions

and meet all admission criteria as outlined in the Candidate Handbook. (Candidates are not allowed to interview until all admission criteria are complete.)
