The meal plan is required of residential students. It includes 19 meals per week: three peak meals a day, Monday through Friday, and two meals a day on Saturday and Sunday. Monday through Friday there is continuous dining from 7:00 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. where students can come into the Dining Center and partake of

soup, salad, deli, pasta, desserts, and grill items if they aren't able to dine during peak meal times.
