REVISED VETERAN BENEFICIARY EXCEPTIONS BASED ON SATISFACTORY PROGRESS

The following addendum appears after the section **Veterans Educational Benefits** (page 37) and prior to the section **Yellow Ribbon Grant** (page 38) of the 2023-2024 academic catalog.

Veteran Standards of Progress and Readmission of Benefits

Every student who is permitted to enroll at Lindsey Wilson College is expected to make continuous progress toward his or her educational objective. This includes those students that are beneficiaries of any VA benefits that come from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. **See the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy in this catalog.**

Any student whose quality of performance is below the minimum scholarship standards will be placed on academic probation or academic suspension.

In most cases, a student will be placed on academic probation prior to being academically suspended. A student who is placed on academic suspension may be given the opportunity to appeal. **See Academic Integrity section in this catalog.**

Students academically suspended must leave the college for a semester. Upon suspension, students receiving G.I. Bill® benefits will not be certified for future semesters and the student's status will be reported to the Veterans Administration.

The Student Handbook addresses student conduct and institutional policy. Upon dismissal for unsatisfactory conduct, students receiving G.I. Bill® benefits will not be certified beyond the dismissal date and the student's status will be reported to the Veterans Administration. The student is held responsible for any debt that may occur once the Veterans Administration makes their determination to request benefits to be returned to them.

Students intending to pursue readmission must follow the College's procedures for readmission to the college. **See the Readmission after Suspension section in this catalog.** When students are officially readmitted to the college, they are permitted to register for classes. Students eligible for GI Bill® benefits may request that their enrollment be certified to the Veterans Administration.
