After logging in you will be prompted to create a new password. Follow the onscreen instructions.







### View/Accept/Modify Your Financial Aid - Continued

- Click the "Award Offer" tab at the top of the page (see right).
- Review each category of aid and accept, modify, or decline each award.
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the "Submit" button.

**Quick note -** Some of the requirements are not able to be satisfied until you attend orientation in person.





After you have viewed and accepted your financial aid offer, return to your myLWC portal to complete enrollment. \*You must click on the promissory note link to complete acceptance of your financial aid.

#### **Understand Your Financial Aid**

To better understand your financial aid offer, please review the following items.

**Institutional Grants/Scholarships**: Institutional Grants and Scholarships are awarded by Lindsey Wilson College. For more information, see www.lindsey.edu/financialaid.

**Federal Grants**: This federally funded grant (Pell Grant) is awarded on the basis of financial need. This grant is the foundation upon which all other aid is based.

**Kentucky State Grants**: These grants, funded by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, are awarded, based on needs to Kentucky residents attending Kentucky colleges and are subject to the availability of funds. The grants are available as a Kentucky Tuition Grant (KTG) and/or College Access Program Grant (CAP).

**KEES Scholarship:** KEES scholarships are estimated based on your current award prior to your high school graduation and final grades. KHEAA requires students to maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA while in college to remain eligible for the KEES Scholarship each year.

**Federal Student Work-Study:** Students work on campus approximately 11 hours a week to earn money. There is a 6% tax that will be deducted from the wages earned. For example, a \$3,000 work-study award will result in approximately \$180 being withheld for taxes. Money and earnings can be directly applied to the student's account or receive a monthly paycheck. New spring students would be awarded \$1,500.

**Federal Direct Subsidized Loan:** This need-based program enables students to borrow an educational loan from the Department of Education. The loan is insured by the federal government, and the federal government pays the interest while the borrower is enrolled in school at least half-time, during a grace period, and authorized periods of deferment. Interest will begin to accrue from the beginning of the repayment period (six months after a student graduates or leaves school). The interest rate is variable, with a threshold of 8.25%.

All students that accept the Federal Direct Subsidized Loan must complete the online Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentaid.gov

This loan will have an origination fee (For example, in 2023-24 the fee was 1.057% for that year) which will be deducted from the total amount of the loan. Freshmen, dependent students are eligible to borrow \$5,500 in student loans for the year. (Subsidized and Unsubsidized combined)

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan: This is a non-need-based educational loan from the Department of Education. The student is responsible for the interest during in-school and deferment periods. Six months after the student graduates or leaves school, payments on the principal and interest begin. The interest rate is variable, with a threshold of 8.25%. Quarterly interest payments can be made while the students are in school, or students may allow interest to accrue. All students that accept the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan must complete the online Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentaid.gov

This loan will have an origination fee (For example, in 2023-24 the fee was 1.057% for that year) which will be deducted from the total amount of the loan.

# COMPLETE THE **ENROLLMENT** PROCESS

You **MUST** click on each link listed on your myLWC Portal to fully complete the enrollment process. In this step, some information will be populated based on information provided during the application process. These fields cannot be edited. If changes are necessary, please contact the Admissions Office.

#### **Student Services Form**

Please be prepared to provide emergency contact information.

### **Housing Contract and Fee**

Complete your Housing Contract via the clickable link or by visiting www.lindsey.edu/housing.

The housing contract fee is \$50. It may be paid online after submission of the housing contract or at New Student Orientation. The priority housing deadline is June 1 for new fall students and Nov 1 for new spring students. For questions regarding residence halls and living on campus see www.lindsey.edu/reslifefaqs.

### Parking Form and Fee

Parking permits are issued by Lindsey Wilson College's Office of Public Safety for \$30. All students are required to purchase a parking permit unless the student will not have a vehicle on campus at any time. Permits may be purchased online via www.lindsey.edu/parkingpermit or at New Student Orientation.

### **Health Insurance Waiver - Student Athletes Only**

All student athletes are required to provide proof of personal health insurance coverage or purchase a LWC provided policy (\$408). Student athletes will be charged for the LWC insurance policy via their student account until proof of personal health insurance coverage is provided. This does not pertain to students who are not participating in a Lindsey Wilson College Athletic Program. Students MUST provide proof of insurance coverage by September 1 (fall new students) and February 1 (spring new students) or the fee will remain on the student's account.

### **Direct Deposit**

If a student has a credit on their account, signing up for direct deposit will ensure that any overages are directly deposited into the student's personal bank account. Sign up for direct deposit using the link shown in myLWC portal or visit portal.lindsey.edu/forms/ap/directdeposit/.

Quick note - You cannot access the page UNLESS you are logged into your myLWC account.

### **Alternate Email Address**

Students are encouraged to provide an alternate email address if they would like their student invoice notification sent to an additional party (eg. parent, guardian).

### **Paying Your Portion**

Lindsey Wilson College offers the following payment options:

#### **Semester Payments**

Semester payments will be made directly to Lindsey Wilson College. Fall Semester payment is due by August 19 and Spring Semester payment is due by January 13.

You have the following options when making a payment to Lindsey Wilson College:

### **Tuition Payment Plan**

We offer a payment plan at a cost of \$55 for each semester. Students are able to invite another payer (e.g., mom, dad, aunt, uncle, etc.) that can make a payment without seeing anything else in the educational record of the student. The student does not see any payment information of the invited payer.

- Banking or credit card information can be saved on the site to have auto payments made.
- Students may access the payment plan option up until a week after classes start.
- The payment plans send out notices before payment is due.
- If a student misses a payment, there is a grace period before a late fee is assessed.
- Visit www.lindsey.edu/paymentplan to enroll.

This document serves as a contractual financial agreement with Lindsey Wilson College.

All students MUST e-sign their Promissory Note.
