
After logging in you will be prompted to create a new password. Follow the onscreen instructions.








How To Accept Your Financial Aid




In order to review awards, you should use the same credentials set up earlier on page 2.







View/Accept/Modify Your Financial Aid

Click the "Offer" tab at the top of the page (see below). Review each category of aid and accept, modify, or decline each award. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the "Submit" button.

Satisfied Requirements are listed below Unsatisfied Requirements. **Quick note -** Some of the requirements are not able to be satisfied until you attend orientation in person.





Understand Your Financial Aid

To better understand your financial aid offer, please review the following items.

Institutional Grants/Scholarships: Institutional Grants and Scholarships are awarded by Lindsey Wilson College. For more information, see www.lindsey.edu/financialaid.

Federal Grants: This federally funded grant (Pell Grant) is awarded on the basis of financial need. This grant is the foundation upon which all other aid is based.

Kentucky State Grants: These grants, funded by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, are awarded, based on needs to Kentucky residents attending Kentucky colleges and are subject to the availability of funds. The grants are available as a Kentucky Tuition Grant (KTG) and/or College Access Program Grant (CAP).

KEES Scholarship: KEES scholarships are estimated based on your current award prior to your high school graduation and final grades. KHEAA requires students to maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA while in college to remain eligible for the KEES Scholarship each year.

Federal Student Work Study: Students work on campus approximately 11 hours a week to earn money. There is a 6% tax that will be deducted from the wages earned. For example, a \$3,000 work-study award will result in approximately \$180 being withheld for taxes. Money and earnings can be directly applied to the student's account or receive a monthly paycheck. New spring students would be awarded \$1,500.

Federal Direct Subsidized Loan: This need-based program enables students to borrow an educational loan from the Department of Education. The loan is insured by the federal government, and the federal government pays the interest while the borrower is enrolled in school at least half-time, during a grace period, and authorized periods of deferment. Interest will begin to accrue from the beginning of the repayment period (six months after a student graduates or leaves school). The interest rate is variable, with a threshold of 8.25%.

All students that accept the Federal Direct Subsidized Loan must complete the online Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentaid.gov


This loan will have an origination fee (For example, in 2023-24 the fee was 1.057% for that year) which will be deducted from the total amount of the loan. Freshmen, dependent students are eligible to borrow \$5,500 in student loans for the year. (Subsidized and Unsubsidized combined)

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan: This is a non-need-based educational loan from the Department of Education. The student is responsible for the interest during in-school and deferment periods. Six months after the student graduates or leaves school, payments on the principal and interest begin. The interest rate is variable, with a threshold of 8.25%. Quarterly interest payments can be made while the students are in school, or students may allow interest to accrue. All students that accept the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan must complete the online Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentaid.gov

This loan will have an origination fee (For example, in 2024-25 the fee was 1.057% for that year) which will be deducted from the total amount of the loan.


The Promissory Note

The promissory note is available after charges are assessed. At that time, the student will be prompted to e-sign the promissory note.



Alternate Email Address


Students are strongly encouraged to provide an alternate email address if they would like the invoice notification sent to an additional party (eg. parent, guardian).



Direct Deposit

If a student has a credit on their account, signing up for direct deposit will ensure that any overages are directly deposited into the student's personal bank account.

Please be advised: If you choose for work study earnings to be directly deposited, it means an additional \$3,000 will be added to your student account balance, effectively making you owe that amount.



Other Ways to Pay Your Portions

Lindsey Wilson College offers the following payment options:

Semester Payments

Semester payments will be made directly to Lindsey Wilson College. Fall Semester payment is due by August 19 and Spring Semester payment is due by January 13.


Tuition Payment Plan

We offer a payment plan at a cost of \$55 for each semester. Students are able to invite another payer (e.g., mom, dad, aunt, uncle, etc.) that can make a payment without seeing anything else in the educational record of the student. The student does not see any payment information of the invited payer.

- Banking or credit card information can be saved on the site to have auto payments made.
- Students may access the payment plan option up until a week after classes start.
- The payment plans send out notices before payment is due.
- If a student misses a payment, there is a grace period before a late fee is assessed.





Housing Contract and Fee


You are able to select who you would like to live with, or we will work diligently to pair you with a person who has common interests. You may even meet the perfect match at orientation.


Vehicle Registration and Parking Fee


RaiderAid Notifications
