From the President's Desk

A Record-Setting Year



To say this has been a record-setting year would be an extraordinary understatement. In the 40 years I have served this College – including the last 25 as president – I can't recall a more exciting time for Lindsey Wilson College. I have never been more pleased to give a year-end report.

Credit for a great year must begin with the remarkable support we received from our alumni and friends. Total gift income surpassed \$4.46 million, the third highest total in College history. Unrestricted giving, which helps provide scholarships for students and support the operating budget, came in at \$1,873,000 – the highest ever. We also had an incredible year in estate gifts. We received the most estate gifts in College history: over \$1.28 million from people that treated us like family and remembered the College with an estate commitment.

In this issue of the *President's Annual Report*, we celebrate individuals who have made selfless contributions to the College. People such as the late **Sam and Allene Holmes**, whose love for the College and devotion to their faith led them to make arrangements in their estate plans to provide scholarship aid to future ministers who attend LWC; and **Russell Polston**, who with his wife, **Maxine**, humbly prepared a revocable trust in their estate plan that left \$668,000 to provide scholarship support to LWC students from Cumberland County, Kentucky.

We celebrated when 705 members of the Class of 2022 made history as the largest graduating class in our 119-year history. We also celebrated our highest fall-to-fall retention rate which came in 14 percentage points higher than the previous fall. And for the first time in College history, we surpassed an enrollment of 3,000 as 3,097 students enrolled in the fall.

A big reason we had a record enrollment is because we have built an incredible small-college faculty who are committed to the success and growth of our students. When Vice President of Academic Affairs Trish Parrish came to me with five faculty nominations for professor emeritus status, it was a no brainer. Those remarkable individuals included: **Robert Reynolds**, 40 years of service; **David Moore** (36 years of service); the **Rev. Terry Swan** (36 years); **Tim McAlpine** (23 years); and the late **Kara Mollis** (14 years). Although their departure will be felt deeply, their colleagues will continue to

carry out the LWC mission to ensure that this College remains strong well into the future.

We have such an exciting future. I believe we have never been stronger than we are today. I love our faculty, staff, and students and the amazing success they are having.

Thank you all for a record-setting year. Our best dreams happen when our eyes are wide open!

Reach Out Into The Infinite: The Gift of a Clock on a College Campus

John Hendrickson was an avid collector. For nearly three quarters of a century, he amassed a collection that included rugs, cars, ship models, dominoes and antiques with a particular interest in 18th-century American furniture.

But his most treasured pieces were a sizable collection of clocks.

"I met John Hendrickson almost 41 years ago when Elise and I had our very first date when she was just 18," said LWC President William T. Luckey Jr., Hendrickson's son-inlaw. "One of the things I noticed as I walked

into the Hendrickson home is that there were clocks everywhere. I mean hundreds of clocks – and none of them had the right time. That collection only grew throughout the years. We always felt loved when he decided to part with one or purchase a new clock as a gift for a special occasion."

In April, members of the LWC community gathered at the entrance of the A.P. White Campus on the top of Lindsey Wilson Hill to dedicate the Hendrickson Clock and honor the cou-



ple that made it possible.

A gift from John and his wife, D.D., the 19foot-tall Hendrickson post clock now stands as an architectural focal point next to the iconic Lindsey Wilson sign. Hendrickson died on Oct. 15, 2021, six months before the project was completed. He was 89.

"John was an engineer by training and he was intrigued and fascinated by the exactness, the mechanisms and the beauty in the instrument," said Luckey. "And while I could never have the same passion for clocks that my father-in-law had, I must confess that I am mes-

merized by the stunning beauty of this particular clock. I had no idea what an incredible impact this gift would have on changing the entrance to our beautiful campus."

The Hendrickson Clock from the Electric Time Company is made from an original casting by Seth Thomas, one of the world's most respected clock brands. Each dial on the foursided clock measures at 36 inches in diameter and features the College name and its founding year. The clock's presentation is



elevated by new sidewalks, brickwork and landscaping installed by LWC's plant staff, with assistance from outside designers and builders. It is the second post clock donated by Hendrickson; the first was in his hometown of Pewee Valley, Kentucky.

At the dedication ceremony in April, LWC First Lady Elise Hendrickson Luckey spoke – along with her sister, Sarah Hendrickson Townswick – about how the clock has transformed what a visitor now encounters when they reach the top of Lindsey Wilson Hill.

"Traveling up this hill for nearly 40 years it has always felt like home," said Elise. "But now as I turn the corner and look up the hill there's a beacon pulling me home. I know that it's special to me. I know I can't walk past it without reaching out and touching it. It is a fitting tribute to Dad, someone who knew how precious time is."

The grounds, brick and concrete work was made possible thanks to additional gifts from LWC trustee Dr. James J. Pike and his wife, Patricia, as well as Elise Luckey.

The Luckeys say Hendrickson would have been pleased with how beautifully the project was executed.

"Bill brought the plans for the new campus entrance to show Dad the week he left us," said Elise. "Dad and D.D. looked over them and his eyes welled up with tears because he could see it – his vision and the impact of this majestic new entrance to campus built around his clock. And now we can all see and understand what Dad envisioned for us."

For more than four decades, John and D.D. Hendrickson have been generous and loyal LWC donors. In addition to the clock, the couple established the Hendrickson Endowed Scholarship, which has grown to \$465,000, one of LWC's largest endowed scholarships.

"This is such a fitting tribute to a dreamer, a builder and a visionary," said Elise. "Dad and D.D. loved this campus and loved our mission. Dad used to say, 'You kids have your fingerprints all over that campus.' Well now, Dad and D.D., you have your fingerprints here as well."

Few families have meant more to Lindsey Wilson College than the Parnell family.

And last fall the College honored the Adair County family by re-christening Blue Raider Stadium as Parnell Family Stadium. The stadium has been the home to Blue Raider football and track and field since it opened in fall 2010.

"The Parnells have been such a remarkable family and we are excited for this day," LWC President William T. Luckey Jr. said at the renaming ceremony on Sept. 11, 2021. "They've had a longtime relationship with Adair County and Lindsey Wilson College. They are the most loving and generous family, and I can't think of a better way to honor them than to put their name on this spectacular facility."

Adair County native and Louisville businessman, Dr. Allan Parnell has been chair of the LWC Board of Trustees since 2012. During his tenure, LWC has seen enrollment levels soar, record graduation and retention rates, and the establishment of the College's first doctoral program.

Parnell also spearheads the annual "All In for LWC, Chair's Challenge" alumni campaign that has raised more than \$4.5 million for the College since 2014.

"When Dr. Luckey first mentioned the fact that I was going to be honored with the naming of this stadium it just overwhelmed me," said Parnell. "It brought tears to my eyes."

Two dozen members of the Parnell family, who have deep roots in Adair County, supported Allan and his wife, Bunny, at the renaming ceremony.

"I'm from Columbia and raised about 10 miles from here as a little barefooted boy," said Allan. "It's hard for me to express how much this means to me. It's amazing. I love this college and love supporting it. This is a happy day for the Parnell family."



Sam '52 and Allene '48 Holmes Couple Creates Scholarship to Prepare Ministers

Adair County natives Sam and Allene spent most of their lives in Charlestown, Indiana, where Sam owned a NAPA Auto Parts store and Allene was a teacher/administrator in the Charlestown school system. When they retired, they returned to their roots and relatives in Adair County to be active in their church and their alma mater.

Sam and Allene loved taking part in Lindsey Wilson College activities, including Homecoming and Founders' Day. Deeply religious, the Holmes decided in 2002 to create the Sam and Allene Holmes Endowed Scholarship for Christian Ministries.

"Sam and Allene were wonderful Christian people who faithfully supported the college for more than 20 years," said LWC Vice President of Development Kevin Thompson. "They wanted to serve His Kingdom, which was why it was important for them to provide scholarships to prepare future ministers at LWC through the Sam and Allene Holmes Endowed Scholarship for Christian Ministries."

When it was time to make estate planning arrangements, the Holmeses knew they wanted their remaining resources to help others. In addition to making gifts to family and friends, the Holmeses made bequests to numerous religious and social charities and entered into discussions with LWC which resulted in a \$100,000 gift to the College at their deaths.

Thompson said that the Holmeses especially enjoyed meeting the students who received their scholarship and hearing about their plans to serve His Kingdom.

"Sam and Allene lived modestly and were savvy investors who tithed and saved for the future," said Thompson. "They were careful planners who wanted to make a difference with the blessings God gave them throughout life."



A love for his native Cumberland County, Kentucky, and his alma mater led Russell Polston to leave one of the largest estate gifts to Lindsey Wilson College.

Russell enjoyed a successful 40-year career in the agricultural credit business in Chattanooga, Tennessee. That's also where Russell met his wife, Maxine, and where they raised a daughter. Professionally, Russell rose to the position as chief operating officer of Chattanooga Production Credit Association, which later became Ag Credit. Russell served as the organization's CEO for 32 years, retiring in 1991.

But during his time in Chattanooga, Russell never forgot Cumberland County and Lindsey Wilson. Through his classmates Dr. Julius Stephenson '47 and Keith Radford '42, Russell remained connected to the region and his alma mater. Russell and Maxine were faithful donors to the College for nearly four decades and they were fixtures at LWC events.

In addition to sharing some of his treasure with Lindsey Wilson, Russell also gave his time. For more than a decade, he faithfully served as President of the LWC National Alumni Association.

Polston Estate Gift is One of the Largest in LWC History

Early in his association with Lindsey Wilson, Russell told college officials that he and Maxine had included the College in their estate plan – through a revocable trust prepared by an estate planning firm in Chattanooga. Little more was said because both Russell and Maxine were humble and did not want to draw little attention to themselves. Maxine passed away in 2013, then Russell in 2021. Lindsey Wilson received more than \$668,000, one of the largest estate gifts in the College's history.

The gift will be used to establish the Russell and Maxine Polston Endowed Scholarship, which will support students from Cumberland County who attend LWC.

"Russell Polston's love of Lindsey Wilson and his native Cumberland County is such an inspiration to all of us because it's a reminder to never forget your roots or heritage," said LWC President William T. Luckey Jr. "Because of the generosity of Russell and Maxine Polston, first-generation college students like Russell will have the opportunity to earn a wonderful Lindsey Wilson education and become leaders and role models in their communities, just like Russell and Maxine were."

Class of 2022 Makes LWC History

Lindsey Wilson College capped off its largest class in school history at spring commencement. At the College's 115th commencement, a total of 296 degrees were conferred – 216 undergraduate degrees and 80 graduate degrees. Combined with the 409 degrees awarded at LWC's winter commencement ceremony, the Class of 2022 was a record 705 graduates – the most in the 119-year history of The United Methodist-affiliated college. The previous record was set by the Class of 2017 when the College awarded a record 688 degrees.

For Hall Abston of Cumberland County, Kentucky, there was no better way to honor his late brother than to invest in the next generation of Lindsey Wilson College nursing students.

"The nursing profession held a special place in the hearts of the Abston brothers," said Sharon Willen who is co-executor of the Abston estate with her husband, Lonnie. "They loved their nurses and received such good care, that's why they wanted to help people in that field."

When Hall's brother, Howard, died he knew he wanted to do something to honor him. So Hall met with First & Farmers National Bank President Vickie Wells in Burkesville, Kentucky, to discuss how to establish an endowment fund in his brother's memory. Wells assisted Hall by putting him in touch with the LWC Development Office.

"Ms. Wells told Hall that an endowed scholarship would be a great thing," said Lannie Willen, son of Sharon and Lonnie. "And after a few meetings with Brady Button, who was then the director of major gifts at Lindsey Wilson, Hall decided that LWC would be the perfect place to assist nursing students with scholarship support."

Hall established the Howard Abston Memorial Endowment Scholarship, a merit- and need-based scholarship to support LWC nursing students from Cumberland and Clinton counties. The gift is the second-largest estate gift in LWC's 119-year history.

"In the last years of his life, Howard had really bad rheumatoid arthritis," said Lannie. "What those nurses did for him made a big impact." LWC Vice President for Development Kevin A. Thompson said the estate gift will have a major impact on the College's outstanding nursing program.

"This is a phenomenal gift that will help change lives in Cumberland and Clinton counties and beyond for generations," said Thompson. "It will prepare nurses who will go out into the world and make it a healthier and better place."

The Willens, who were longtime family friends of the Abston brothers, have played an important role in helping to fulfill Hall's wishes.

"The Abston brothers were crop and hog farmers together in Cumberland County for years," said Lannie. "They lived in a very frugal way. I would often go to Howard for advice because he was one of the smartest men I've ever met and was pretty much self-taught by all the books and farm journals he read."

Sharon said the Abston brothers' generosity extended beyond farming.

"They were so good to my kids," Sharon said. "They were always bringing them things. Anytime there was something interesting happening, like a solar eclipse or whatever, they'd bring the kids the proper equipment to view it. Most of the time, I wasn't even aware that stuff was happening. They always did things like that."

Residence Hall Memorializes Members of the LWC Community Who Served 'Every Student, Every Day'

When LWC trustees Jerry and Kendrick McCandless suggested renaming the residence hall that bears their name, LWC President William T. Luckey Jr. hoped a little time would persuade the couple to reconsider their decision.

"I asked if we could percolate on it for a few months and have the conversation again," said Luckey. "So we did, but again, the shoe never felt comfortable."

LWC experienced a housing boom during the 2011-12 academic year. The Jerry and Kendrick McCandless Hall was opened to ease residential overcrowding by adding space for 156 female students.

But after the challenges and hardships brought on by the COVID pandemic along with the loss of several LWC faculty and staff members who died while in service to the College, the McCandlesses felt it was time to rename the hall.

"Eleven years ago we dedicated this building, and the message is the same today as it was then," said Jerry McCandless, a of Campbellsburg, Kentucky, resident. "God took the mismatched, unwanted, undesirable materials and our beloved maintenance department in conjunction with God and produced this beautiful building as an addition to our campus."

The Biblical significance of that was not lost on Jerry McCandless.

"I said then and I say it now, that's what God did for us through Jesus Christ," said McCandless. "So today we rededicate this building as Memorial Hall to honor those of our Lindsey Wilson family who have passed from this earth. Kendrick and I are so humbled to be able to participate in this dedication of those who modeled 'every student, every day.""

Football Honored in Frankfort

Members of the 2020 Lindsey Wilson College football team were recognized in March on the floor of the Kentucky state Senate for winning the NAIA National Championship on May 10, 2021. Kentucky State Sen. Max Wise of Campbellsville introduced a senate citation to honor the 2020 champions. The citation recognized and honored Lindsey Wilson football for its "extraordinary performance during the 2020-21 athletic season," which culminated with a national title. The 2020 Blue Raiders won the program's first national title with a win over Northwestern (Iowa). The national title came in the program's 11th season.

Cycling Reigns as BMX National

The Lindsey Wilson College cycling was tops in the nation in BMX cycling as the Blue Raiders won the USA Cycling BMX National Championship in March. It was the program's second BMX national championship. The Blue Raiders beat nine other programs from across the country. It was the fourth national title in program history as the Blue Raiders also captured two cylcocross titles (2000, 2001) and its first BMX title (2012).

A couple's lifetime commitment to support Lindsey Wilson College students has been enshrined in the Norma and Glen Hodge Center for Discipleship.

On April 20, the College community gathered to dedicate the

Doug and Betty Jean Moseley Auditorium, the main room of the Hodge Center for Discipleship.

"We are happy to be here today to honor a family who continues to bless Lindsey Wilson College and our students," LWC President William T. Luckey Jr. said at the ceremony. "This room is filled nearly every day with students from different backgrounds and cultures learning and growing in the knowledge and love of

Christ Jesus. Their legacy and life's calling will live on for generations through the lives of these students."

The Moseleys served the College from 1959-70. Doug was a religion professor and later chaired the religion department. He also served as assistant to the president for development. He re-

ceived an honorary doctorate of humane letters from LWC in 2010. Betty Jean taught English, and she was named an Honorary Alumna of the College in 2022.

"I believe Doug would be pleased today," Betty Jean said at the naming ceremony. "Doug loved Lindsey Wilson and had a longtime association with the College, dating back to the 1940s when he attended youth camp here."

Over six decades, the Moseleys have made more than 172 distinct gifts to LWC. That includes establishing the Doug and Betty Jean Moseley Endowed Scholarship, which has grown to \$264,000. In 2013, the Moseleys donated a collection of 480 books about U.S. presidents to the Katie Murrell Library. The books are on display in the Thomas D. Clark Reading Room.

Doug died in 2017 at the age of 89. The Moseleys had been married for 63 years at the time of his death.

"Doug held many positions (at LWC), but the job he cherished most was teaching basic Christian beliefs and mentoring young people who were going into the ministry," said Betty Jean. "So I think it's fitting that his name be here in this building and I'm thankful for this opportunity."

Five Named Professor Emeritus by the LWC Board of Trustees

Five individuals from Lindsey Wilson College have been named professor emeritus by the LWC Board of Trustees. The emeritus title is conferred upon an individual who has been recommended by the LWC faculty and president in recognition of their exemplary service to the College.

The College's new professor emeriti are Tim McAlpine, retired professor of English; Robert Reynolds, retired professor of music; the Rev. Terry Swan, retired professor of religion and dean of the chapel; David Moore, retired professor of history; and the late Kara Mollis, who was associate professor of English and dean of the School of Arts and Humanities.



23 Years of Service Tim McAlpine

Professor of English Tim McAlpine is the embodiment of the Lindsey Wilson College mission. For more than two decades, he has thoughtfully and dutifully served the students and the

greater LWC community, making the campus and the region more culturally diverse.

A foundational member of the College's English program, McAlpine developed the curriculum to teach underprepared incoming students how to write for college while also propelling English majors into professional fields. He served as the English department chair for more than 11 years.

McAlpine graduated from Westmont (California) College and then earned a doctorate in English from Purdue University. Following his undergraduate years, McAlpine spent more than nine years in Japan, where he worked as an English instructor at two Japanese universities, Baika University and Kinjo Gakuin University.

When he came to LWC, McAlpine arranged for LWC to become a sister school to the two Japanese universities. As a result, dozens of students from Japan have spent at least a year at LWC, with McAlpine serving as their advocate and adviser, teaching them English, and helping them become immersed in American culture.

"It's been a wonderful opportunity for our Japanese students because they love coming to Columbia," said McAlpine. "They know that when they come to Columbia they are coming to a place that does not have a Japanese-American population, so they are forced to learn more about America than they would be in a city with a large Japanese-American population, where the temptation might be to fall back on their own language and culture."

McAlpine cares about every aspect of the student experience. He can regularly be seen sitting in the bleachers at athletic events or attending musical performances and academic presentations. He even took part in a couple of cocurricular activities when he appeared alongside students and colleagues in two TheatreFest! productions, *Our Town* and The *Sound of Music*.



40 Years of Service Robert Reynolds

For Professor of Music Robert Reynolds, a 90-minute recital has turned into a 40-year career at

Lindsey Wilson College. Reynolds came to LWC at the start of the 1980-81 school year after performing a recital in May of 1980. It's safe to say, almost every graduate of LWC over the next four decades took a music class taught by Reynolds.

A well-known concert pianist, Reynolds performed countless times on campus and throughout the region as a soloist and with small ensembles. His collaboration with the Louisville Symphony Orchestra has created opportunities for hundreds of LWC students to have experience performing with professional musicians. As a music teacher and professor, he is devoted to the mastery of his discipline and instilling in students the importance of ongoing practice and study.

"In those five decades since I made the naive decision to follow a dream of playing piano on the concert stage, there

has been more stillness and study than sound, more pondering and practicing than performing," he once said. "Such an unhurried musical emergence is summed up by a single line in John Buchan's novel, Greenmantle: 'Then slowly from the silence there distilled drops of music.""

Reynolds was one of the most respected members of the College's faculty for his leadership and commitment to students. He earned a bachelor's degree from Campbellsville (College) University and a master's and doctorate degree in musical arts from the University of Kentucky. Before his retirement in 2021, Reynolds was LWC's longest-serving active professor.



36 Years of Service Rev. Terry Swan

The Rev. Terry Swan arrived at LWC in 1985 as the college was transitioning from a junior college into a four-year liberal arts college. Swan helped usher in some of the most transformative years in LWC history over the next three decades. Those changes included two building booms, the addition of two dozen degree programs, a threefold increase of the student body, and the College's first doctorate degree. Most importantly, Swan took part in planning the John B. Begley Chapel, the College's first freestanding chapel, which was dedicated in 1997.

Swan joined the LWC faculty as a psychology professor and as the College's chaplain. When he retired from the College more than 30 years later, he held the title of professor of religion and dean of the chapel

Swan served for two years as vice president of academic affairs and was a key member of the faculty team that developed the College's curriculum during its nascent years as a baccalaureate college. He also helped design and launch the College's bachelor of arts program in Christian ministries, which has sent dozens of students into ministry and service.

Swan earned a bachelor's degree from Centenary College in Louisiana; a master's degree and a specialist degree from Western Kentucky University; a master's degree from Asbury Theological Seminary; and a doctorate from Vanderbilt University. Swan retired from LWC in 2021.

The author of more than 30 books – including the bestselling *What in the World Am I Doing Here?* and *The Bal-* *ance Book* – Swan has been a very popular speaker on campus and throughout churches and at workshops in the Southeast.

But one of Swan's greatest legacies at LWC is his work teaching and advising students. And the students responded favorably to Swan's instructional approach. He was named Teacher of the Year a record five times by the LWC student body.

"What we've found is that many college students today simply have not grown up reading the Bible," Swan once said. "Instead we start out where (the students) are and move them toward an understanding of the classic doctrines of Christian faith."



36 Years of Service David Moore

Professor of History David

Moore says he was attracted to Lindsey Wilson College because of the mission.

"When I first met with college leaders they talked about the mission. I had never heard of a mission before in higher education," said Moore. "So I found it to be very unique to find a college that had a mission and then lived it every day."

When Moore joined the LWC faculty in 1985, he was one of the first faculty members hired who had earned a doctorate. It was a time of dramatic growth as the college transitioned from a junior college into a four-year liberal arts college.

Moore, who earned a bachelor's and master's degree from Eastern Illinois University, had recently earned a doctorate from Miami (Ohio) University when he came to LWC. His first assignment at LWC was to build a bachelor of arts program in history. He also helped start a bachelor of arts program in social science.

For the next 36 years, Moore tirelessly served in those programs – perfecting the courses and curriculum. Moore's influence inspired dozens of LWC graduates to pursue professional careers in history, law, political and social science, and education.

"Dr. Moore has a lasting legacy that can be found in generations of LWC students," said LWC Associate Professor of History Elizabeth Tapscott. "Without him, Lindsey Wilson would not have a history program, let alone a healthy program that continues to grow."

Outside of the classroom, Moore served as chairman of the humanities division and served on numerous academic committees and task forces. He established the LWC chapter of Alpha Chi, the national college honor society. He was instrumental in creating the Noma Dix Winston Endowed Scholarship for history, and he also established an endowed scholarship for English in honor of his late wife, Delorah, who was a beloved former LWC English professor.

Highly regarded by his peers and students, Moore is as much known for his story-telling and his ability to bring the past to life as he is for his rigorous academic standards. He was recognized three times as an outstanding professor by the LWC student body with the prestigious Teacher of the Year award. He also received the United Methodist Church Exemplary Teaching Award, an award voted on by his faculty colleagues.



14 Years of Service Kara Mollis

The late Professor of English Kara Mollis was Lindsey Wilson

College's inaugural dean of the School of Arts and Humanities. A passionate educator and administrator, Mollis championed initiatives and programming that deepened her students' educational experience. An accomplished scholar in 19th- and 20th-century American literature, Mollis began to shift her research on women's and gender studies, social justice, and human rights.

But what distinguished Mollis – who died in June 2021 after a brief battle with breast cancer – were her efforts to expand and broaden the LWC curriculum so that students would benefit from more diverse options.

Mollis, who began her LWC career in fall 2007, said that her favorite courses to teach included "Women Writers," "Feminist Theory" and "Women in Global Perspective." She found satisfaction in introducing them to feminism and authors that included Allen Ginsberg and Toni Morrison. Never one to shy away from a challenging topic or controversial discussion, Mollis encouraged her students to become socially and politically aware.

Mollis helped provide additional campus opportunities for students to learn and apply activism and social justice. That led to her helping create the bachelor of arts in women's and gender studies and significantly strengthen the women's studies minor. She also founded the College's Women's and Gender Studies Annual Academic Conference and created the Women's Student Union. Mollis also introduced the popular "Brown Bag Lunches," where students and faculty gathered over a midday meal to freely exchange ideas.

LWC Associate Professor of English Allison Smith, who was one of Mollis' close friends, said her colleague was a person of both ideas and action.

"Kara always fought fiercely for the things that mattered to her: teaching students the value of literature and women's equality; fighting for the underrepresented and making sure they had a place in her classroom; advocating for the humanities on campus and beyond; and creating a community for her friends and colleagues," said Smith, who succeeded Mollis as dean of the School of Arts and Humanities.

LWC students recognized Mollis' devotion to teaching and the LWC mission when they named her Student Government Association Teacher of the Year.

Mollis earned a bachelor's degree from Washington & Jefferson (Pennsylvania) College and a master's and doctorate degree in English from Duquesne (Pennsylvania) University. She was frequently published in academic journals and presented at national and international conferences.




